3. SANITARY REGULATIONS FOR KITCHENS, CANTEENS,  
EATING AND DRINKING PLACES, ETC.

- (i) In order to assist in the prevention of infectious disease, the following measures are ordered:-
  - (ii) The spread of certain infectious diseases may be attributable in some measure to the lack of proper sterilization of glasses, cups and other drinking utensils, also knives, forks and spoons after use by one individual before being used by another. Each establishment, military or civil, within the lines of camps, cantonments, etc., shall, therefore, be required to install a simple appliance for sterilization.
  - (iii) Civilian establishments failing to comply with these regulations will be placed "out of bounds" to all troops.
  - (iv) All cups, dishes, knives, forks and spoons should be protected from flies and dust.
  - (v) All utensils used in the handling, preparing, baking, cooking, serving and storing of foods and beverages, shall be kept clean and in good condition at all times.
  - (vi) The surface of tables, etc., used for preparing and serving food must be kept clean at all times and if of wood with open cracks will be covered with non-absorbent material.
  - (vii) Ample facilities shall be provided for washing, cleansing and disinfecting the utensils and apparatus used for eating, drinking, or preparing food. There shall be provided washing and sterilizing sinks and receptacles.
  - (viii) All glasses, cups, knives, forks, and spoons or dishes, that are subjected to repeated use, shall be thoroughly washed after each use, by cleansing with hot water to which has been added a cleansing agent, and then immersed in a suitable receptacle in boiling or scalding water for three minutes or subjected to the action of a chlorine disinfecting solution (200 parts available chlorine per million) for at least two minutes.
  - (ix) The boiling or scalding water method (190 to 212 degrees Fahrenheit of sterilizing, requires a strong wire basket 6-8 inches deep with handles on each side extending several inches above the top of the basket in order that it can be lifted easily into and from the water. The size of the basket will be such as to fit easily into a sink or receptacle holding the water, and it should be strong enough to withstand the strain when filled with utensils. With several such baskets the process of sterilization can be carried on easily and rapidly. These baskets can be made locally. The boiling or scalding water method is considered to be less likely to be troublesome in operation than the chlorination method.

- (x) The chlorination method requires facilities for rinsing following disinfection as for instance a sink full of running water.
- (xi) After sterilization (or rinsing when necessary) articles may be allowed to dry in the air for which purpose racks may be provided.
- (xii) The use of dish cloths is not prohibited, but these should be in sufficient number and should be sterilized by boiling and dried between use.
- (xiii) There shall be provided a ventilating hood over every cooking range effectual for removal of all smoke, gases, vapours, and odours; the same to be connected to smoke chimney.
- (xiv) There shall be provided and kept available at all times proper wash basins with adequate supply of soap and individual clean towels; roller towels are prohibited.
- (xv) All eating and drinking places, as well as ice-boxes, refrigerators and store-rooms, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and free from insects, vermin and flies. Windows, doors and other openings shall be properly screened. Adequate sanitary receptacles shall be provided for garbage and refuse. Dry sweeping of floors is prohibited.






