The attention of all concerned is directed to Routine Order 218, which is amended and republished below:

1. All ranks of the C.A.S.F. are warned against communicating, either verbally or in writing, any item of information respecting Naval, Army or Air Force matters which may be of value to the enemy.

2. In particular, private correspondence should make no mention of the following:

(a) The disposition, movement or projected movement of warships, merchant ships, troops or aircraft.

(b) Details as to numbers, armament, equipment or condition of ships of all kinds, troops or aircraft.

(c) Any measures which have been taken or which are projected for the defence of any place.

3. This order is to be repeated in the orders of all C.A.S.F. units, training centres, etc., and will be read once each calendar month to company, or equivalent unit, parades.

5. DISCIPLINE.

With the expansion of the Active Militia of Canada and the creation of the Canadian Active Service Force, it is possible that many Officers and men have not realized the full implications of the instructions laid down in King's Regulations and Orders for the Canadian Militia, 1939, para 417, 423 and 1462, which provide for the proper method of making representations and complaints. It is most necessary, therefore, that the procedure, which gives ample scope for the making of such representations and for proper attention being given to them, should be fully understood.

2. There are two points of view to be considered:-

- (a) The right of every Officer and man to make known his grievance or his suggestion, and the countervailing duty which this right imposes upon superiors of giving advice in an understanding manner and to meet representations in the same spirit.

It is part of the training and responsibility of Officers and N.C.O.'s. to have regard to the well being of the individuals under their authority. The greatest care should be taken to preserve a humane and sympathetic relationship. The Soldier making a reasonable complaint, as contrasted with a frivolous complaint, should not feel himself restrained from doing so by a belief that it will be treated with indifference or reproof.

- (b) The status of the Active Militia of Canada as a body under the King, and Parliament, responsible for its own discipline and entrusted with its own internal administration.

It is essential, that if the Active Militia is to serve the State efficiently, that all its members should observe a proper sense of discipline. It is not possible to maintain discipline if individual members of the Active Militia make their representations, not through the established channels which allow of their being dealt with in an orderly way, but to persons or authorities outside. Such a method of making complaints, apart from the fact that the individual complainant seeks an advantage for himself over those of his fellows who observe the proper practice, renders it difficult for those in authority, to whom the complaints are thus indirectly referred, to deal with them in a satisfactory manner.

The C.O. is placed in an invidious position if he finds that a man under his command, instead of approaching him and giving him an opportunity of disposing of the matter, has applied to a senior authority with the result that he only hears of the existence of the complaint from above.

3. All C.O.'s. are therefore, requested to make generally understood to the personnel of their units the practice and principles of the Active Militia in dealing with complaints and in attending to representations and the reasons underlying this practice and these principles.


