

3. SECURITY OF OFFICIAL INFORMATION
 - (1) All members of a HQ, including all signal operators, signal office personnel and drs of HQ cars are reminded that they are employed in a posn of trust and are, therefore, under an obligation of secrecy.
 - (2) No military information which may come to a person's knowledge as a result of employment at a HQ will be communicated to any person NOT employed at such HQ, except when necessary in the performance of duty. Information which may seem quite trivial may possibly give a clue to important military matters, with disastrous results to our Forces. Everyone, therefore, will make a definite rule NOT to mention any phase of their work to any person or to discuss any phase of their work with another member of the staff, when there is any possibility of being overheard. Particular discretion will be observed when talking on the telephone with regard to military affairs. Signal operators and signal office personnel, likewise all drs of HQ cars, are warned that any conversations regarding military matters they may overhear during the performance of their duties must be treated as secret and confidential.
 - (3) Members of a HQ will NOT communicate confidential or secret information to other members of the staff unless it is necessary for the proper performance of their duties.
 - (4) The following are relevant extracts from the Official Secrets Act, 1911 (IML p.895) as amended by the Official Secrets Act, 1920 (IML p.900) which Acts of the United Kingdom apply to personnel of the Cdn. Army Overseas.
 - I. A person is guilty of a felony and liable to penal servitude for a term of fourteen years who for any purpose prejudicial to the safety or interests of the State,

(a) Makes any sketch, photograph, plan, model or note which is calculated to be or might be or is intended to be directly or indirectly useful to the enemy.

(b) Obtains, records, publishes or communicates to any other person any secret official code word or pass word, or any sketch, photograph, plan, model, article or note, or other document or information which is calculated to be or might be or is intended to be directly or indirectly useful to any enemy.

II. A person is guilty of a misdemeanour and liable to imprisonment for a term of two years who,

(a) Having in his possession any code word, pass word, sketch, photograph, plan, model, document or information, communicates such code word, pass word, sketch, photograph, plan, model, document or **information** to any person, other than a person to whom he is authorized to communicate it, or a person to whom it is in the interest of the State his duty to communicate it:

AND WHEREAS prior to the execution of the Army Will I had executed a last Will (hereinafter referred to as the Civilian Will), the date of which I do not know.

NOW I HEREBY DECLARE this to be a codicil to the Civilian Will, and I hereby declare my intention to revive the Civilian Will and all codicils thereto and I declare such Civilian Will and all codicils thereto to be and contain my last and only Will and testament.

I HEREBY REVOKE MY said Army Will.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand this.....day of.....A.D. 194.....

It should be noted that whereas one original only of M.F.M. 10 or 10(a) are to be completed, two copies of the above form are to be executed. 2-A

1. Notwithstanding the instructions in Overseas RO's and Pmr's Circular Letters, soldiers continue to arrive at hospital without Parts I and II of their Service and Pay Books. This causes great difficulty in maintaining proper records of cash payments to these soldiers.

2. CO's will therefore make the necessary arrangements within their units to ensure that when soldiers proceed to hospital they have both parts of their Paybook with them, or, failing this, that the Paybook is despatched to the hospital as soon as possible after the soldier is evacuated.

3. In order to carry this out, unit arrangements will include the following:

- (a) Soldiers will be instructed to carry their Paybooks at all times including when going on sick parade.
- (b) Unit pmrs will regulate the number of Paybooks called in to be written up so that no paybook will be retained for more than 48 hrs.
- (c) Unit Pmrs will be informed daily of soldiers admitted to hospital, and if, in an emergency case a soldier has left without his Paybook, it will be fwd at once by the unit Pmr to the Pmr of the Fd Amb, CCS or Hosp concerned.
