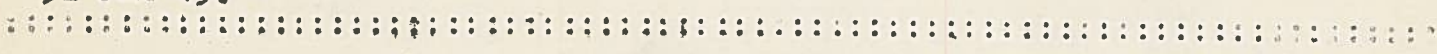

3-A

1. Overseas R.O. 2305 is hereby amended as follows:

DELETE para 5 and substitute:

"5 "CANADA" PATCH AND BADGE

(a) All personnel will wear a badge, shoulder, "CANADA", worsted issued by Ordnance, on each sleeve of battledress and greatcoat; provided that where the Title or Designation adopted clearly indicates that personnel are Canadian, the wearing of the said Canada badge will be optional. Uniformity will, however, be maintained within each Arm or Service which is on a corps basis and within each unit of other Arms. The "CANADA" badge referred to has 5/8" straight lettering, is 2 1/2" in extreme width and will be worn on both sleeves 1 1/2" from the should seam. Officers will obtain their requirements of badges, shoulder, "CANADA", worsted, from Ordnance on prepayment. Trade pattern "CANADA" badges will not be worn.

(b) With service dress all officers will wear a metal "CANADA" badge, appropriate to the Unit or Service, at the base of the shoulder strap. This badge will measure 1 1/2" in extreme width, with 3/8" letters and will have straight bars top and bottom."





On Friday the 5 Feb 43 at 1030 hrs the Princess Louise Fusiliers had the honour to organize and put on a demonstration illustrating the tactical and practical use of the Ronson Flame Throwers mounted in Carriers.

Those in attendance at the Demonstration included the Cdmr 1st Cdn Army Lieut.Gen. A.G.L. McNaughton, the Cdn Chief of Staff Lieut.Gen. Stewart, the G.O.C. in C. British Home Forces General Padgett, the Cdmr of the 1st and 2nd Cdn Corps Lieut.Gen. Crerar and Lieut.Gen. Samson, the G.O.C. 4th Cdn Armd Div Maj.Gen. F.F. Worthington and numerous other Generals and Brigadiers.

Major General F.F. Worthington, himself, handled the running commentary and discription of the Demonstration.

The first phase of the Demonstration of an attack on a German Inf Coy posn carried out by a Sqn of Ram tanks from the 28 Cdn Armd Regt, a Ronson Coy from the P L Fus and a Motor Coy from the Lake Sup R (M). The attack was carried out with great success the Tanks leading the break, through mines and wire and rapidly taking up a covering posn after having broken through the enemy defences. The tanks were closely followed by the Ronson Coy using flame and so successful was this attack that 88% of the straw filled sacks placed in slit trenches and pillboxes were burnt out. Following this the Inf from the Motor Bn followed up to do the final mopping up and their advance being covered by the tanks, the Carrier borne Ronsons and the Scout Pl of the Motor Bn. The attack was a success and the Victory Signal was fired by Maj.Gen. Worthington. The attack was well co-ordinsted and very well executed.

The second phase of the Demonstration was the loading and unloading of a Ram tank on a tank transporter carried out by the 1st Cdn Tk Delivery Regt and the 69th Cdn Tk Trptn Coy R.C.A.S.C.

The third phase was a section attack on a small defended post, the attack to burn out the position. The attack was carried out using a smoke cover and one Sec. Ronsons advancing supported by a Scout Section supplied by the Lake Sup R (M). The attack was a success and the post properly burned out.

The fourth phase was a demonstration of firing by the Ronson using first Marine Diesel fuel and then a special mix. The range was well demonstrated and the qualities of the mix found to be much better than that of the Marine Diesel. Following this the Flame Thrower Barracuda was demonstrated for the first time and was found to be greatly superior to the Ronson in the manner of firing and the range.

The final phase was a demonstration of a fuel mixer, mounted on M.T. and for use in the field.

The whole of the Demonstration lasted from 1030 hrs until 1215 hrs and was a great success, carried out with perfect co-operation, timing and without any hitches.

The G.O.C. has been pleased to convey his thanks, and that of the Army Cdmr, for the fine manner in which the demonstration was carried out.
