3. BREACHES OF SECURITY REGULATIONS BY OFFICERS.

Further examples of disciplinary action taken against personnel guilty of breaches of security regulations are published.

(a) An Army Officer was convicted on two charges of having unlawfully communicated information relating to activities against the enemy to two Officers of the Allied Forces who were not persons to whom he was authorised to communicate it. At the time of the offences he was engaged in duties of highly secret nature. In the course of the conversation with two officers of the Allied Forces with whom he was acquainted he disclosed to them information as to the nature of his duties. He was sentenced to be dismissed from His Majesty's Service.

(b) An Air Force Officer was convicted on a number of charges of conduct to the prejudice of good order and Air Force discipline. He was stationed overseas and wrote letters home which he gave to a Merchant Navy Officer to post on his arrival in the United Kingdom without passing through the censor. In these letters which contained information as to the location of his Unit he attempted to arrange a code so as to be able to arrange to communicate his future movements. He was sentenced to be dismissed from the Service.
