- (ii) This instance in cited in order to bring to the attention of all ranks that there are some booby traps still lying around unit areas which are dangerous as they were before VE Day.
- (111) The moral is Don't go poking around unoccupied buildings. Don't tamper with suspected booby traps unless you are qualified to do so
- (iv) If a building or object is known or suspected of being booby traped, notify nearest RUE units or apply for assistance through HQ RUE.

### OUT OF HOUNDS

- 2 (i) All cafes or reasturants are OUT OF BOUNDS to all ranks.
- (ii) Due to shortage of food in Holland it is necessary for troops NOT to increase difficulties by consuming civilian food supplies.

- (11) The following extracts from Cdn RO (21 A Gp) 700 are to be drawn to attention of all Or:-
  - (a) When the tie is wern, the hooks and top button only of the battledress blouse will be open.
  - (b) When the tie is not worn, the blouse will be buttened up to the top.
  - (c) No ties will be worm during parade hours
- (iii) The above applies only to occasions when the battledress blouse is worn, and in no way affects the regs laid down in First Cdn Army HO 907 which deals solely with summer dress.

#### DRESS - WEARING OF WHITE WEB E PT

- 5 (1) Attention is drawn to 5 DRO 106 dated 4 May 45.
- (ii) Reports continu to be received that the provisions of this order are not being followed. The Regt Pro Secs reciently formed within 5 Cdn Army Bde, 11 Cdn Inf Bde and Arty to augment 5 Cdn Pro Coy will be permitted to wear white web eqpt. The practise of wearing white web eqpt other than authorized above, will cease forthwith.

#### LOSS OF VEHS

The number of WD vehs being lost or stolen has greatly increased since the cessation of hostlities. During ops it was inevitable that some vehs would be lost as whe op necessity prevented strict compliancs with the instra for dafeguarding of vehs. During the present static period, it is considered that the majority of losses of WD vehs only be attributed to negligence.

#### ACCIDENTS

- 1. Due to a recent check up made of accidents occurring within this fermation it is apparent that the greater percentage of them are caused by negligent driving and speeding. The accident rate has been by far too high and will be reduced forthwith.
- 2. While this formation was engaged in ops in many cases speed was necessary and accidents which occured were due to this. Now that ops are completed the need for speed is no longer present and limits as laid down will be adhered to rigidly. Any offenders will be punished severely.
- 3. It is to be noted that when an accident occurs and vehicle is sent to workshops copy of the accident report must accompany the vehicle.
