

(b) No driver is permitted to deviate from hms authorised route except in cases of necessity.

(c) AF G 3518 will be compiled and used in accordance with the instrs published in "MT DRIVERS REGULATIONS" and printed on the inside cover of Transport Work Tickets Book modified as under:-

- (i) Columns 8 - 13 (incl) and MPG for week will be complete
- (ii) AFs G 3518 will not be submitted for audit, but offr commanding will ensure that all such forms are examined weekly to ensure that the transport has been economical and properly used.
- (iii) Completed tpt work tickets will be retained for a period of six months and then destroyed.
- (iv) All work tickets will be signed by an offr who will be responsible that the vehicle allotted to a task is the most economical for that task.
- (v) Wherever possible, tpt carrying personnel or stores will be loaded to capacity on both outward and return journeys. Particular attention will be paid to the reduction of dead mileage.

BOOBY TRAPS

1 (i) At VZ718 ALMELLO recently a civ was killed by a booby-trapped tin of cigarettes. The investigating Offr was unable to find any trace of booby trap mechanism.

(ii) This instance is cited in order to bring to the attention of all ranks that there are some booby traps still lying around unit areas which are dangerous as they were before VE Day.

(iii) The moral is - Don't go poking around unoccupied buildings. Don't tamper with suspected booby traps unless you are qualified to do so

(iv) If a building or object is known or suspected of being booby trapped, notify nearest NCB units or, apply for assistance through HQ RUC.

OUT OF BOUNDS

2 (i) All cafes or restaurants are OUT OF BOUNDS to all ranks.

(ii) Due to shortage of food in Holland it is necessary for troops NOT to increase difficulties by consuming civilian food supplies.

(iii) Disciplinary action will be taken against any offenders.

LIGHTING

3 All requests for electric power from civ sources will be submitted to the Town Major of the area concerned. Units will not use civ electricity without the approval of the Town Major, and will not approach civ authorities directly.

4 (i) It has become increasingly apparent that the smartness in dress of personnel within First Cdn Army has fallen far below the desired standard. The necessity of having personnel properly turned out at all times cannot be too strongly stressed, especially now that hostilities have ceased. It is the desire of the GOC-in-C that the prestige of the Cdn Army gained during hostilities be maintained at the highest level.

(ii) The following extracts from Cdn RO (21 A Gp) 700 are to be drawn to attention of all Or:-

- (a) When the tie is worn, the hooks and top button only of the battledress blouse will be open.
- (b) When the tie is not worn, the blouse will be buttoned up to the top.
- (c) No ties will be worn during parade hours

(iii) The above applies only to occasions when the battledress blouse is worn, and in no way affects the regs laid down in First Cdn Army RO 907 which deals solely with summer dress.

DRESS - WEARING OF WHITE WEB EQPT

5 (i) Attention is drawn to 5 DRO 106 dated 4 May 45.

(ii) Reports continue to be received that the provisions of this order are not being followed. The Regt Pro Secs recently formed within 5 Cdn Army Bde, 11 Cdn Inf Bde and Arty to augment 5 Cdn Pro Coy will be permitted to wear white web eqpt. The practise of wearing white web eqpt other than authorized above, will cease forthwith.

LOSS OF VEHS

The number of WD vchs being lost or stolen has greatly increased since the cessation of hostilities. During ops it was inevitable that some vchs would be lost as whe op necessity prevented strict compliancs with the instrs for safeguarding of vchs. During the present static period, it is considered that the majority of losses of WD vchs only be attributed to negligence.

ACCIDENTS

1. Due to a recent check up made of accidents occuring within this formation it is apparent that the greater percentage of them are caused by negligent driving and speeding. The accident rate has been by far too high and will be reduced forthwith.
2. While this formation was engaged in ops in many cases speed was necessary and accidents which occured were due to this. Now that ops are completed the need for speed is no longer present and limits as laid down will be adhered to rigidly. Any offenders will be punished severely.
3. It is to be noted that when an accident occurs and vehicle is sent to workshops copy of the accident report must accompany the vehicle.


