1. ARMS

1. Following are rules for carriage of arms in British zone of GERMANY. FIRST - personal arms need not in future be carried in British zone of GERMANY, except as stated. SECOND - Arms will be carried (a) by mil police gds, sentries on duty and personnel on patrol. (b) when escorting personnel of womens services outside local areas as defined by fmn comds.

2. BATHING - PATERSWOLDE LAKE

1. Due to the contaminated condition of the PATERSWOLDE lake revealed by an investigation by 11 Cdn Fd Hyg Sec showing a high content of human excreta, this lake is now placed OUT OF BOUNDS for bathing for all ranks.

3. BUS SERVICE - GRONINGEN TO LEEUWARDEN

1. Effective Saturday, 11 Aug 45, Colonial Coaches operating between GRONINGEN and ASSEN, will run a service between GRONINGEN and LEEUWARDEN. Time table as below.
2. Troops will be permitted to take one civ each on the buses. Coaches will NOT have a stop until civ release form has been signed.
3. Civs are NOT permitted to travel on CFM buses running to APELDOORN.

(a) Bus Terminals Groningen - GROOTE MARKT

(b) Buses from APELDOORN will make connections for Leeuwarden at Groningen.

(c) 0930 run from Leeuwarden connects with 1100 run from Groningen to Apeldoorn.

4. DRESS - AFTER PARADE HOURS

1. Battledress with web belt or shirt and web belt.
2. When blouse is not worn shirt sleeves will be rolled and ties will be worn. Braces will not be worn without blouse.
3. When ties are not worn blouse will be buttoned up at the neck.
4. This includes dances.
5. The above will be strictly adhered to by all OR's.

1. BUS SERVICE


1. Can Military personnel may now take one civ female on CFN Bus service. Bus dvrs will carry civ release forms and coaches will NOT leave stop until form has been filled out. This is the only exception to the regulation that civs will NOT be carried.
2. Para 3 of Part I Order No. 54 is hereby cancelled.

2. ELECTRICITY

1. A case has occured in town of personnel using electricity in their billets.
2. This results in electricity, which is meant for civ consumption only, being cut off.
3. Any such cases being reported in future will result in disciplinary action being taken.

3. LEAVE - CONTINENT

1. Personnel proceeding on leave to the Continent are advised that it is impossible to purchase either cigarettes or tobacco in PARIS or BRUSSELS at present.


1. CIGARETTES ORDERS
RESUMPTION OF QUOTA CONTROL

1. Following infm has been received from CFN :

1. quota control on gift and purchase cigarettes orders was suspended on 18 May 45 on all orders from NW EUROPE and repat depots in the UK to ensure speedier handling in 2 Tobacco Depot.
2. It was possible to continue the relaxation of quota control as long as excessive amounts were NOT ordered. It is evident that orders have now greatly increased notwithstanding the number of personnel repatreated and there is no doubt that cigarettes are being obtained for purposes other than the personal use of individuals.
3. Reports from CDA indicate that repats are bringing back large quantities of cigarettes. If this situation were allowed to continue there is grave danger that the tobacco coys will withdraw from the tobacco scheme. They have already indicated that they are unable to continue shipments on the same scale as formerly.
4. Stocks of cigarettes held at 2 Tobacco Dep are now dangerously low and the present rate of withdrawals cannot be continued.
5. In view of the above, quota control is being resumed immediately on all gift and purchase orders. As a result it will no longer be possible to continue the guarantee of 48 hrs service on priority orders although every effort will be made to despatch the cigarettes from 2 Tobacco Dep within the shortest possible time after receipt of the orders. Some delay in the del of individual orders may be expected but in view of the serious situation outlined in this letter this is unavoidable.

2. CLOTHING - ILLEGAL DISPOSAL OF

1. It is apparent that mil personnel are giving away or selling to civs articles of mil clothing and eqpt, contrary to the provisions contained in First Cdn Army RO 866. In particular this practice is prevalent where civs are emp in or about mil ests, such as canteens, wksp, messes, etc.
2. This ^{un}authorized issue or disposal of Cdn battledress and other articles of mil clothing to civs is having a serious effect on the sup of mil clothing, and a continuation of the practice will result in inability to meet demands. It will be the responsibility of unit comds to ensure that action is taken to stop it.
3. Disciplinary action will be taken against any offr or soldier found to have broken the provisions of this order or found to be deficient articles of clothing without a satisfactory explanation.

2. It should be noted that all packages shipped by MFO may be opened for examination by Canadian Kit Storage Depots, & Customs officials.




